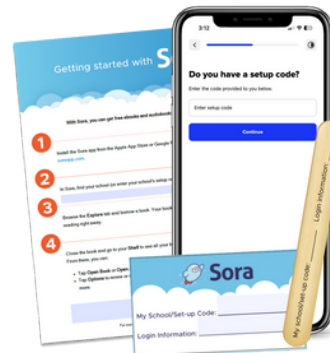


This self-paced curriculum is intended for librarians and educators at Sora schools.

Ensure students can sign in

Before school lets out for summer break, ensure students can **confidently sign into Sora on their personal devices**. Try these best practices and resources:

- Add a [direct link](#) to your Sora sign-in page and/or your [Sora setup code](#) to your school website, social media channels, newsletters, or wherever students and families access information!
- Visit classrooms or host your own Sora training or refresher for students.
- Share [customizable getting started guides](#), [Sora ID cards](#), or [how-to bookmarks](#).
- Leave instructions for summer school instructors or media specialists to help students access Sora.



Prepare your digital collection

If you're responsible for managing your school's digital library, the end of the school year is a great opportunity to check in on your digital collection and prepare for summer reading in Sora.



Manage holds: Before break, check on student demand in Sora and consider how you'd like to address [digital holds](#) for in-demand titles. Review the [Manage digital holds](#) module to learn more and contact your Sora team for help!

Update curation: [Curated collections](#) appear on the Explore tab in Sora for students, and help guide readers' discovery of digital content. Consider updating your curated lists to reflect summer reading themes, and to guide students toward recommended titles, exciting digital formats, or new genres to explore.

Promote summer reading on Sora

Increase awareness and create a strategy to reach students and families with promotional graphics, printables, and more from the [Resource Center](#).

- ★ Encourage students to set a [reading goal](#) before break. Consider hosting a reading challenge or tying into summer reading initiatives!

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Connect students with summer reading content
