

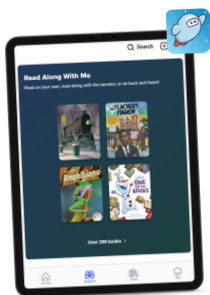
SORA FOR YOUNG READERS

MAKE SIGNING IN SIMPLE

Students will log in to your school's digital library on Sora. In most cases, Sora uses the login information your students are already using for other websites at school. [Setup codes](#), [direct links](#), or [QR codes](#) can help students find your school's sign-in page quickly.



HELP WITH APP NAVIGATION

Help your young readers (and prereaders) [identify Sora icons and buttons](#) and [navigate Sora](#). Build practice into class instruction, learning centers, or other opportunities.

GET PARENTS INVOLVED

With Sora, the reading doesn't have to stop when the school day is over. Increase Sora awareness and let families know that students can access free, age-appropriate ebooks and audiobooks 24/7 at school or at home on a personal device. CONNECT STUDENTS WITH DIGITAL BOOKS

[Sharing direct links](#) helps you connect your youngest students with the titles you recommend. With direct links, students don't need to search or browse for titles in Sora. Instead, you can point them to a specific title, collection, or list of search results to choose from.

Filters are your friend! [Search with filters](#) or [narrow down lists and collections](#) in Sora. Use them to find specific formats, like [read-alongs](#) or [comics](#), books at a [specific reading level](#), available-now titles, and more. When recommending a specific book, [make sure there are enough copies available](#) before sharing a direct link.
