Sora's Reading Challenges are fun, time-based competitions that encourage students to read for more minutes or meet more reading goals.

Sora users can create up to five and participate in up to two challenges at time.

Creating challenges

1. Log in to Sora.
2. Find **Reading Challenges** on the Me tab and select **Create Challenge**.
3. Enter the challenge details:
 - a. A challenge name—names must be unique, so consider adding a date range or other unique identifier!
 - b. A duration between seven and 365 days. Challenges begin at 12 a.m. local time on the start date and end at 11:59 p.m. local time on the end date. If you select today as the start date, the challenge begins right away.
 - c. The challenge type (most minutes or minutes per day).
4. Customize your challenge badge.
5. Review the challenge details and check the box if you'd like to join the challenge.
6. Select **Continue** to create the challenge and share it using the provided QR code, challenge link, or challenge code.

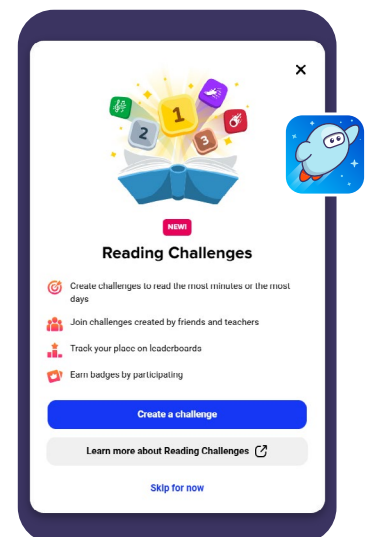

- **Prevent the summer slide:** Keep reading habits strong with summer challenges and fun incentives—challenges are the perfect complement to Sora Sweet Reads!
- **Think big:** Host readathons, Drop Everything and Read (DEAR) campaigns, or use challenges to align with your district's Sustained Silent Reading (SSR) efforts.
- **Boost creativity and agency:** Enlist students to design badges, craft unique challenge names, or create "Beat the Teacher" challenges for extra fun.
