

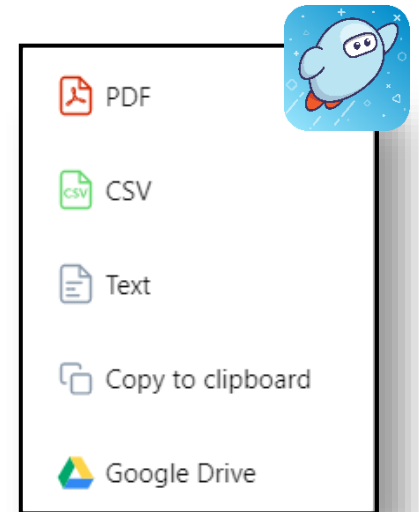
# Exporting in Sora

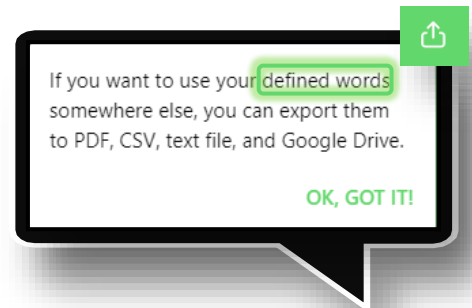

## Reflect

*How can exporting support learning procedures?* Consider the application of this feature with your students and your curriculum. Use the ideas below to begin brainstorming.

- **Simplify submission of homework and assignments**  
Students can export and share new vocabulary, answers to comprehension questions, or reflections with a teacher.
- **Enable class collaboration, book discussion, or assessment creation**  
Learners can save time by sharing information directly from the app, without having to rewrite or copy from the book. Students can collaborate by sharing exported notes and highlights.
- **Assist with pre-work and preparation**  
Exporting enables students to prepare for class discussions or projects while reading.
- **Aid documentation and real-time records**  
Learners can keep track of their growing vocabulary, or thoughts while reading, and save exported lists to their personal device or digital portfolio. Educators can store and organize student work, tracking readers' development over time.
- **Support remote learning**  
Exporting facilitates collaboration between learners, and between students and their teacher, even remotely.
