>>> Overview

Like borrowing physical books, users can borrow digital books from your library with Libby.

Access free ebooks, audiobooks, magazines, comics, graphic novels, and streaming video anytime, anywhere. *Note:* The selection will vary based on your library.

In Libby, titles return automatically on their due dates - with no late fees!

Libby Overview (8 minutes). Get a short, thorough overview of how to use the Libby app.

>>>> Install Libby

Install Libby on virtually any device. Choose what works for you:

- Download the Libby app on your <u>iOS</u> or <u>Android</u> device or on newer <u>Fire</u> tablets.
- Access Libby in your Chrome, Firefox, Safari, or Edge web browser at Libbyapp.com.

Libby is compatible with Apple CarPlay, Android Auto, Sonos speakers, Amazon Kindle, and more.

Find your library and sign in

- Sign in for the first time (1 minute).
 - Set up Libby on multiple devices (1 minute).





Pro Tip! If users have trouble signing into Libby, they will need to reach out to your library for assistance. This is because your library manages sign in information and statuses (e.g., PIN number or password, expired card status), not OverDrive.

1. Download the Libby app or access it in your web browser.

2. Open Libby and find your library.

3. Sign in with your library account details.
