



Learn what's possible with OverDrive Marketplace and how to use it to customize your library's digital collection.

Note: This curriculum has been prepared for library staff that do not purchase but who may create carts and manage other aspects of the digital collection.

1 Identify your setup

If you are in a **standalone** library, you have one digital collection for users in your service area.

If you belong to a **consortium**, your digital collection is shared by users across multiple libraries. You may also have an **Advantage** account, which allows you to purchase additional titles and copies for your community.

2 Discover Marketplace

<u>OverDrive Marketplace</u> is the back-end shopping and administrative portal for library staff. This is where you will build and manage your library's digital collection.

3 Sign into Marketplace

Check your inbox for an email from **donotreply@overdrive.com** containing your username and a link to activate your account. Visit marketplace.overdrive.com to sign in with your credentials.

Login and navigate (3 minutes).



Note: Most users will sign in with a username that contains ".lib."

If your library has an Advantage account, your username will contain ".adv."

Build your digital collection


With Marketplace, you can search for titles and build carts to meet the needs of your library's community.



Search for titles in Marketplace (5 minutes).

Once digital titles are purchased by your OverDrive administrator, your patrons can access them in your digital collection using Libby.

You can guickly review ownership statistics for titles in your collection at any time directly in Marketplace.


