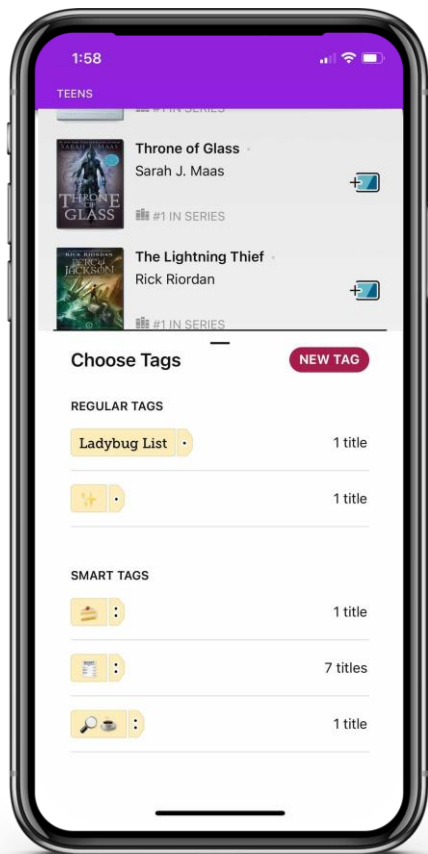




Tagging Titles

How to tag titles and add smarts in Libby

Tags



- Organize book in Libby
- Tag titles across libraries
- Create as many tags as you'd like



Create tags to **get notified** when new issues of a magazine* are added!

*Check to see if your library offers magazines.

Recap – Syncing tags between devices

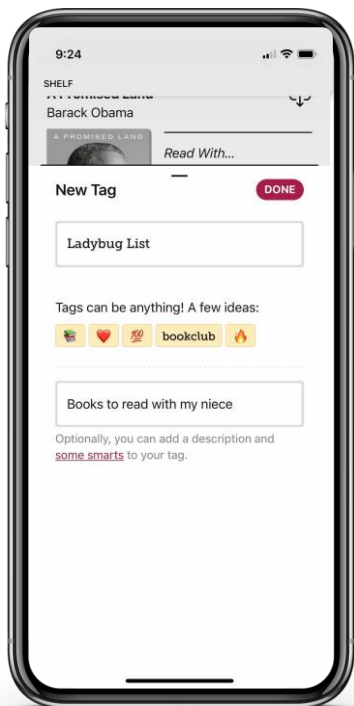


- Download Libby on your additional device(s).
- Open the app.
- When asked if you have a library card, tap **Yes**.
- Tap **Copy From My Other Device**.
- Follow prompts.



*If you didn't use a setup code, please **Reset** Libby and follow the above steps to ensure tag syncing.*

Recap – Regular tags

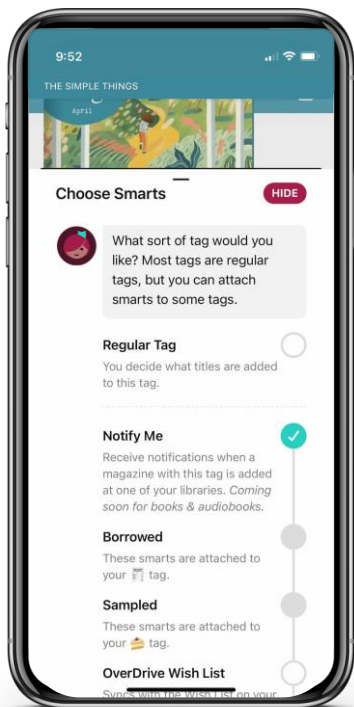


- Tap **Tag** on a title's details screen or in a list.
- Tap **New Tag**.
- Create name, and description if you'd like.
- Tap **Done**.



*Manage tags on your **Shelf**.*

Recap – Smart tags

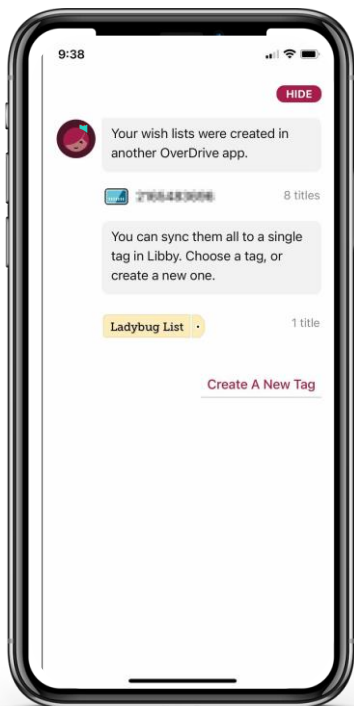


- Tap **Tag** on a title's details screen or in a list.
- Tap **New Tag**.
- Create name, and description if you'd like.
- Tap to add **Some smarts**.
- Choose between **Notify Me**, **Borrowed**, or **Sampled**.



*Libby will automatically create **Borrowed** and **Sampled** smart tags. If you delete them, you can manually add these smarts later.*

Recap – Syncing OverDrive Wish List

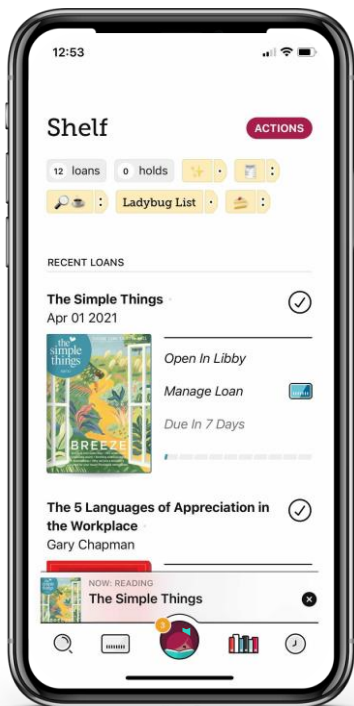


- Tap **Libby Main Menu**.
- Tap **Sync Wish Lists** notification.
- Choose a tag or create a new one.
- Create name.



If you dismiss the notification, you can manually create a wish list tag.

Recap – Manage tags



- Tap **Shelf**.
- View tags in yellow across the top.
- Tap tag to view details.
- Tap **Actions** to rename, export, or delete tag.
