Your library is part of a **consortium**. This digital collection of ebooks, audiobooks, and more is shared by patrons/users in your service area.

You may also have an **Advantage** account, which allows you to purchase additional titles and copies for your community.

2 Discover Marketplace

<u>OverDrive Marketplace</u> is the back-end shopping and administrative portal for library staff. This is where you will build and manage your library's digital collection.

Check your inbox for an email from <u>donotreply@overdrive.com</u> containing your username and a link to activate your account. Visit marketplace.overdrive.com to sign in with your credentials.

Note: Most users will sign in with a username that contains ".lib."

If your library has an Advantage account, your username will contain ".adv."

4 Build your digital collection

With Marketplace, you can shop, build, and purchase carts to meet the needs of your library's community. Once digital titles are purchased, your patrons can access them in your digital collection using Libby.

- Review and purchase carts (4 minutes)
- Lending models overview (4 minutes)
